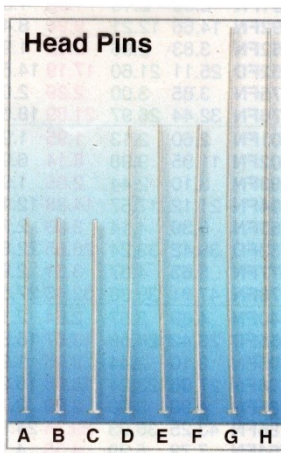


ANGEL MAKING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Put a seed bead on the headpin first, this is to keep the larger beads from falling off of the headpin.
2. Put a large bead on the headpin, this is the body.
3. Sometimes you may want to use a bead cap. Put it on before the wings.
4. Put the angel wings on the headpin.
5. Put the small bead on the headpin, this is the head.
6. Put a rondelle on the headpin, this is the halo.
7. Hold the headpin with a pair of pliers, about $\frac{1}{8}$ to $\frac{1}{4}$ inch from the rondelle (halo) and at the place on the pliers that will be the size of loop you want.
8. Take the top part of the headpin with a pair of pliers and bring it down and around the pliers that you are holding the headpin with.
9. Twist the wire around itself, directly above the rondelle. Be sure to wrap the wire all the way around and do not leave any of it sticking out.
10. Take the headpin off of the pliers and put the lanyard hook on it through the loop that you just made.
